



**A Learnership** is a structured learning programme that combines theoretical learning and practical workplace experience, culminating in a qualification that is registered with SAQA. A person who successfully completes a learnership will obtain a qualification registered on the NQF.

**The CETA** provides skills development services to the construction sector, to implement the objectives of the National Skills Development Strategy (NSDS III) and to ensure that people obtain the critical or scarce skills that are needed to build the capacity of the construction sector to become economically sustainable and globally competitive.

#### LEARNER BENEFITS

- Fixed-term employment contract for the duration of the learnership enables learners to gain practical experience and increase employment opportunities.
- Learners obtain a nationally-recognised qualification that is relevant to the sector;
- Learners can still earn an income while enhancing their skills in their immediate working environment. This will ultimately enhance their career prospects; and
- A learner's personal development and self esteem improve when they obtain a good qualification.

- The government offers tax incentives to companies for participating in learnerships. SETAs offer cash grants for learnerships.

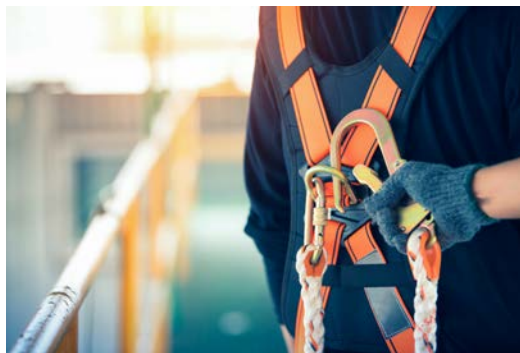

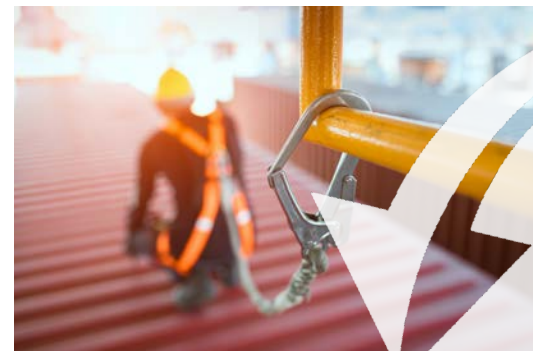

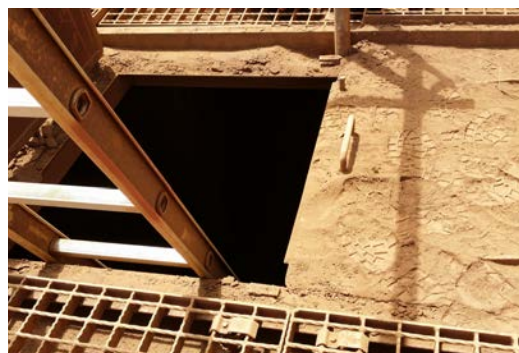
